


Trinity of Goodness Prayer Service 2020

Response

Leader: God is Good and the source of all Goodness, in all things and at all times.

All: *This Goodness is made visible to us through all of Creation.*

Leader: The source of all Goodness is the Trinity, one God in a communion of Divine Persons, who brings into life and wholeness all that exists.

All: *In Jesus Christ we encounter the Incarnate Goodness of the Trinity, the Word made Flesh who came to make a home with us.*

Leader: The Trinity is the source of and dwells within our very being and we are invited to be part of the life of the Trinity, a life of total self-emptying Love.

All: *It is this Love which creates all things and it is this Love that holds all things in being, without it we couldn't, and wouldn't, exist.*
